






LitFest - Parking IMPORTANT PLEASE READ

- When on-site car park is full, please use Car Park 2 at the local village hall







LitFest Cup Football Tournament Rules



- Offside rule applies as normal.
- Roll on roll off substitutions.
- Maximum of 18 players squad size
- Maximum of 7 different substitutes can be used per fixture.
- Maximum of 3 instances in a game can be used to make substitutions.
- Players may be taken off and re-introduced at any time with the permission of the match official.
- Coaching staff may only enter the field of play after referees' permission.
- All players must wear shin pads, before entering the field of play.
- In the event of a kit clash, away team will wear 2nd kit or if no 2nd kit will wear bibs
- No spectator may enter the field of play.
- Any use of foul/abusive language on or around the field of play may result in your team being removed from the tournament.
- Yellow Card = Mandatory 1 Match Ban
- Red Card = Mandatory Tournament Ban

Where not specified, all other laws of association football will apply.

- REFEREE DECISION IS FINAL!!!
- In all other aspects, the organisers decision is final.

Group Matches

- No Half Time.
- No Added Time.
- No Extra Time.

LitFest Gold Cup and Silver Cup Matches

- Include a max 5min Half Time period.
- No Added Time.
- No Extra Time.

Group Stage Scoring

Points will be awarded:

Win 3 PointsDraw 1 PointLose 0 Point



Group qualifiers will be decided in order by:

- 1 Highest number of points awarded
- 2 Greatest Goal Difference
- 3 Head-to-Head result between the two teams in the group stages
- 4 Greatest number of goals scored
- 5 Sudden death penalty shoot out
- Penalties 5 per team
- Draw after 5 penalties,
 Sudden Death Penalties

If a knockout match is a draw at the final whistle the game will be decided by:
